KETCHIKAN, Alaska – The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has issued a Temporary Flight Restriction (TFR) within a half-mile radius of the Wolfe Point landslide. This restriction applies to all non-essential aircraft, including drones, and is in place to ensure the safety of emergency response crews and ongoing debris removal operations.

Unauthorized flights in the restricted area pose a significant safety risk and may interfere with response efforts. Pilots and drone operators are urged to respect this restriction and check for updates before operating in the area.

Officials will continue to monitor conditions at the landslide site and will adjust restrictions as necessary. Updates will be provided as more information becomes available.
