### **For Immediate Release:**

KETCHIKAN, Alaska – The slope remains unstable, with two of the four identified hazard blocks still in place. The highway will remain closed for the rest of the weekend.

At the request of DoT&PF, SECON crews plan to begin construction on a temporary single-lane bypass to restore limited daytime travel around the slide area. The bypass will be controlled by spotters and flaggers, with an anticipated completion early this week.

Once the bypass is complete, motorists should expect significant delays and are advised to only travel through the area if absolutely necessary.

Crews will continue working as quickly and safely as possible, and updates will be provided as more information becomes available.
