KETCHIKAN, Alaska - The two-lane bypass opened as scheduled at 6 a.m. this morning and will remain open until the stabilization project and full roadway repairs are completed.

While the bypass is open for travel, the site remains an active construction zone and may be subject to intermittent stops as needed to complete necessary work. These stops are not expected to be extended and will be limited to tasks such as pothole repairs or blasting if required. Most of these closures will be for ongoing maintenance of the bypass, as the high traffic volume and gravel surface require frequent upkeep.

This will be the final official release regarding the Wolfe Point Landslide from the Emergency Operations Center. **Moving forward, all updates and communications will be provided by ADOT&PF and SECON.**
